The Trefoil is the magazine of the Trefoil Guild, produced three times a year and distributed via the Guild Secretaries. The cost of the magazine is included in the annual subscription. Additional copies may be obtained, on payment of a fee, from the Trefoil Guild Office.

Talking Trefoil

Talking Trefoil is *The Trefoil* magazine in audio-cassette form for the blind, partially sighted or otherwise incapacitated members of the Trefoil Guild. It has the same content as the magazine, is produced at the same time and is free to all members of the Guild *instead* of the magazine. Through a network of one national coordinator and 29 local coordinators all areas of the UK are covered, with the tapes being posted to listeners. Details of any member wishing to receive a cassette instead of a magazine should be sent to the Trefoil Guild Office. Please include the name of the member's Guild. Cassette players can also be provided free of charge, if necessary.

All about *The Trefoil*

Publication dates are March, July and November. The Trefoil Guild Office staff deals with magazine distribution and all relevant enquiries should be addressed to CHQ. Details of the Editor's address can be found in *The Trefoil* magazine. *The Trefoil* Editor works from a separate office and is not available for consultation at the Trefoil Guild Office or by telephone. There is a small editorial group providing assistance to the Editor.

Submissions to *The Trefoil*

- contributions from members are most welcome but there is no budget for payment
- send all copy and photographs to the Editor (not to CHQ) at the address given on the contents page of the magazine, where you will also find the deadline dates for each issue
- copy should be submitted, if possible, by email or on disk (Word 7 or earlier). Typed or longhand copy is also acceptable. If submitting in longhand please write all proper names in capitals for clarity's sake
- mark all contributions with your name, address, telephone number, Guild, County and Country/Region
- email copy will automatically be acknowledged by email. If you wish hard copy to be acknowledged, please include a stamped addressed envelope
- please do not send anything other than copy or photographs to the Editor. All other enquiries of any nature should be sent to the Trefoil Guild Office

Articles and Letters

- keep contributions short and to the point and send them immediately after an event so that they are as topical as possible, bearing in mind that the next issue may be four months away. If a letter to the Editor is not intended for publication, please make that clear
- keep full-length features to 300 words, 250 if accompanied by a photograph. Articles over 600 words are rarely used
- bear in mind that a major event such as an international gathering, will probably have been covered already by a commissioned writer
- do not send articles similar to ones recently used as repetitiveness is always avoided

Photographs

- please send good clear prints, either in colour or black and white. Alternatively send email pictures in j-peg format
- newspaper cuttings or computer-generated photographs printed on paper are not acceptable
- if using a digital camera select the highest resolution available
- each photograph should be identified with a descriptive caption and must bear the name of the person to whom it should be credited. If professional photographs are sent please obtain reprint permission, preferably in writing, from the photographer or newspaper concerned, before sending the picture, otherwise it cannot be used. Please indicate that this permission has been granted
- the best photographs are those which show people in action rather than lined up facing the camera
- close-ups are better than images of distant figures
- if taking a photograph for the front or back page, please use portrait format rather than landscape
- avoid writing directly on the back of the photograph or using paper clips, as either causes damage
- for your own sake do not send priceless, irreplaceable photographs for which *The Trefoil* can take no responsibility
- photographs cannot be returned unless accompanied by an sae
